


The Best Way to Get Sized For a Hyo Silver Ring

Visiting with an associate at our retail location in Bandera, Texas or at one of our booths at special events is the best way to get the correct sizing for the stock catalog ring or custom order ring. If you can't make it to our store location for professional sizing, you can use the paper ring sizer for a best estimate. Please remember this tool is a guide and does not ensure an accurate measurement.

How to Use the Paper Ring Sizer

- 1. Use a ruler to verify the printed paper size on the graphic to the right.
- 2. Cut out the ring sizer below.
- 3. Wrap the ring sizer around the widest part of your finger to where it fits snugly.
- 4. Take note of the number that lines up with the slit in the paper sizer.
- 5. Measure several times for accuracy.
- 6. Add a half or whole size to this measurement for our wider bands, see below*
- 7. Ring sizes are available in half or whole sizes. If in between sizes, we suggest ordering the larger size.



*Add a Half or Whole Size to the Measurement.

Add a ½ to full size if ordering an especially wide ring like SKUs with a ¾ in. back and ¾ in. or ¼ in. front like RRR005, R045, R042, R043 R049, R038-BLK, R038-SVR, RRR011, and custom SKUs BSR019SB, BSR019, BSR045, BSR050RR, BSR050, BSR038, BSR049, BSRRR005SB, BSRRR005, BSR042, BSR043.
